New Business: The foundation and structure supplied by Robb Building Systems for the new sand and salt shed has been completed.

New sand and salt shed dirt work, Project 1 has been completed and Project 2: asphalt, building floor and pad in in process.

The requisition for the second bill from Rubb for \$61,738.50 is in process.

Katie Ela attended a meeting with DOT regarding replacing the bridge by the North Fryeburg Fire Station with either two steel culverts or two box culverts. There was discussion as to whether the road would stay open or be closed during the replacement project which is estimated to be in 2018. More meetings will follow.

The town received \$5252.00 from the National Forrest in lieu of taxes.

Steve Dupuis – Cemetery committee- noted six to eight broken headstones when flags were being put out. Epoxy has been used in the past to repair. Steve estimates \$500 – \$600 would be needed to repair the broken stones. He will be working on repairing broken stones. There was discussion also on using old fence pipe from the back side of Hillcrest Cemetery to build fences around two cemeteries off Wiley Road.

Steve also would like to GPS mark all the cemeteries in town to make it easier to find them.

The Warrant #17 for \$9834.70 was approved and signed.
