Diana Davis updated Selectman on progress for Town Report. Selectmen will review warrants for the town meeting. D. Davis presented a spreadsheet indicating the 3/12's of PY budget. She does not anticipate that the town will go over the 3/12's before the town meeting, except for the snow account, which is an account we are permitted to pay in excess of the 3/12's. Jim Wilfong will write the Selectman's letter for the Town Meeting booklet. The goal is to have all pages of the Report ready by next meeting, 3/08/2022, so that the report can get to the printer.

Diana Davis recommended that the Town keep a Computer account each year to pay the subscriptions for the software and to maintain the computer systems.

Open Issues:

Roads - Jim Wilfong is going to order more culverts no and have them delivered May 1st or so. We will monitor payments for these, so we do not exceed our 3/12ths. (\$39,250) He also stated that he anticipates the cost of Tar to increase this year.

Jim Wilfong had a Zoom meeting regarding the Broadband initiative. There is over \$400 million in the State fund for this initiative, according to Senator Angus King.

New Business - Selectman will buy 'heavy load' posters for the roads.
