

Road Committee Meeting

April 9, 2026

Meeting called to order: 6:30pm

No minutes available from the last meeting to approve. Will do those at next meeting.

Old Business:

Steve has reached out to the company regarding the grinding schedule. Has not heard back from him yet.

The stone house weight sign was picked up. We can bend it back over and replace it. No need to purchase another sign.

Steve attended the county commission meeting. They do not have money at this time. The prison is using up most of it. He did meet with our Rep and can advocate in Augusta for us about emergency road management.

Rob has reviewed prior minutes of the County commission and it seems they have already set the commitment and our cost should be lower.

Road weight ban: will hold off a few more weeks, expecting rain in the next week.

New Business:

Bid opening: 3 Bids submitted. Drew Corp, Kheil, Burke

Steve asked if we can use any of our own material. Carl thought we could use some of it but not the 3". We had not indicated to any contractor that we would be able to supply any materials. Their bids should include all material. Rob Prue could have done a spec sheet for us but that would have cost probably \$10k more.

Carl suggested the possibility of hiring a supervisor to oversee the job on lake rd. Coleman has some inhouse but they will be busy in Conway this year. Can we use Sebago Technics to come out to supervise? We do have the general service agreement.

A suggestion of having a conversation with Drew corp was made. We need to know the start and finish time frame, an earlier start would be ideal. They would need to have a bond and a check of work prior to final payment.

Steve motioned to accept Drew Corp bid, Sarah second.

Carl also would like him (Robbie Drew) to understand he answers to the Road committee as well as selectboard. He also needs to do the complete job at once, not sections at a time. It also might be prudent to take grading marks prior to the start so we can have something to compare to at the completion.

Steve asked Mike how Drew's work was at the fairgrounds last summer. Mike indicated he did a good job. Finished the punch lists not issues to report but there was an overseer at the job. Drew did a section of Rt5 last year and it seems to be acceptable.

Steve to work out the details with Drew Corp and get back to the Road Committee.
