### EQUIPMENT

-Steve spoke with Troy Morse about the power screen and he says they use it regularly. It works great and he is glad we have it.

-SB will table the idea of selling the power screen for now.

### ROAD MAINTENANCE

-Plowing has been going very well so far and roads were well sanded during the ice storm

-Reach out to Kiehl for the last three invoices from grading

-For next year's budget, we will need to make sand next year

-Good to have three years supply

-Put the job out to bid

-Spectrum has cleared out all of their stuff

### FEMA

-The final installment of 68K check was received 1/8/26

-The remaining \$7,000 for Nancy's admin costs will not be issued to the town until all of the FEMA work for the state of Maine for these two storms is completed.

### S.CHATHAM ROAD

-Carl says we need to build up material over the new culverts so the water will run away rather than over the top.

-Ask Alan Eastman if he can do this in the spring when he is finishing up the job of building out 2 feet on either side of the road.

-Alan has completed about 50% of the build out

### KEZAR LAKE ROAD

-Rob Prue from Pine Tree engineering finalized the engineering plans for the grant

-We will ask him to send us one full-size set of plans

-We will invite him to our February road meeting to discuss the plans

-Next step will be to put the job out to bid

- Saco Valley Fire & Rescue contract was originally signed in 2019, and renews annually
- Fryeburg Fire & Rescue is a 10-year contract 2017-2027
- Both go up by a certain percentage each year
