New Business

- Treasurer's report: no invoice from Burke yet, we used approximately \$5000 worth of gravel from our pit.
- Final report from Hastings about the foreclosure: unable to locate heirs, the town has done its due diligence. Kevin Killroy has already assessed will find the email in regards to that. Nancy to put on website when the land is put up for sale. Anticipated sale will be in late fall.
- MMA risk reduction grant available \$3000 is due by sept.
- Kezar Lake grant reimbursement by sept, we need to send in pictures and final report
- Town Hall is open as a cooling center during hours of operation and will post on facebook.
- Harvest Hills contract signed and check sent
- Town Clerk report: some interest in deputy clerk position, we will need a good job description and will leave open until we find a good fit
- Some complaints on 113B, mail lady considering not delivering mail: she should reach out to someone on the selectboard. Any complaints should be directed to the selectboard either call or email or attend a meeting.
- Road Report: Grade set on Union Hill rd and work has been completed. Some larger material was used as a base, made the road a little wider in

sports, culverts were removed that were unnecessary and we did not use any new culverts

- We are continuing the monthly maintenance on Rt 113b, much of the washboarding is caused by speeding.
- Maine Dot Regional office has been contacted for guardrails on the bridge: Susan Norton will let us know when a crew will be in our area anticipating fall replacement
- Lake rd beaver issue, we will be installing panels now that the water is down. Warden service has still not returned a call
- Union Hill rd: Fadden pit empty now, we will anticipate an invoice from Fadden as we pulled a few loads off of their pile
- We would like to get a quote from Manzer for the 2.4 miles of Union Hill north of Meadow rd
- Burke has gone up to look at upper section to quote some ditch repair work
- Road meeting was cancelled rescheduled this thurs. 7/16
- Unfinished Business: Emergency Management plan- no issues with it but needs revising : needs Town of Stow added in to the template
- Community Survey: change pop. growth in first question- resend with changes
- CEO of Sweden offered same as what we paid Alan:
- Cemetery committee: cleaning supplies partially purchased, will be scheduling
- Planning Board: Revised sign ordinance, working on fireworks ordinance for next years warrant
