Selectmen Meeting Minutes January 17, 2017

Opening: The Board of Selectmen meeting was called to order at 6:00PM on January 17, 2017 in Stow by Richard Meserve.

Approval of Agenda: The agenda was unanimously approved.

Approval of Minutes: The minutes of the previous meeting were unanimously approved.

Town Clerk Business:

Open Issue: Richard talked with Joe Higgins about the snowmobile trail on Deer Hill Rd. He said it will be moved next year. He told Ryan Albert and they all agreed.

Richard met John Cleveland on the 11th with bid specs for the New Sand and Salt Shed Project. He has a meeting coming up with John Skully on the 20th.

New Business: Steve Goldsmith came in to go over the Fryeburg Rescue budget.

Trisha Chatman is a new resident of the Town and wanted to sit in on the meeting and learn more about the Town.

We received a notification from Shore Land Zoning (DEP), Mike Morse, our plan needs to be updated. Richard gave copies to the Planning Board and Jim Wilfong. This would tie in with writing a Comprehensive Plan.

Selectmen wrote a letter to Friends of Lovell Recreation to notify them that they need a money figure in their article. They need to write a new article and have a new signature page or let it be brought up on the floor at Town meeting.

The selectmen received thank you letter from Life Flight.

Selectmen talked to Gabe about getting handle on the icy build up on the roads. Asked him to use more salt and scrape the roads when it melts. Assured him that he could use whatever amount of salt necessary to keep the ice down.

Warrant #2 for \$58,945.68 was approved and signed.
