Treasurer Business:

Open Issue: John had a meeting on July 3rd at 11:00AM with Maine DOT Ben Foster, Assistant Bridge Maintenance Engineer, regarding Ezra Heald Bridge. The report shows a lot of repairs need to be done. Need to see if there is any cost sharing available. Meanwhile what needs to be done ASAP – temporary decking, guard rails repaired, sand removed, and wear timbers put on.

The people that were notified to get permits for the building they have built on South Barbour Rd are working on getting them.

New Business: Selectmen decided they need to meet with Planning Board to discuss where the SMPC dues should be paid from in the future.

Sand & Salt Shed: John will call Gabe Watson to ask him to remove the sand he dumped at the Sand & Salt Shed.

Ray will call to order salt.

Carl Drew will give the selectmen a price to finish the small roof at the Sand & Salt Shed.

Robbie Drew and Fred Wilson will both give the Town of Stow pricing for winter sand.

Warrant #14 for \$5,478.87 was approved and signed.
