Selectmen Meeting Minutes 4-23-2019

**Opening:** The Board of Selectmen meeting was called to order at 6:00pm in Stow, Maine by Margaret Robbins.

**Approval of Minutes:** Minutes unanimously approved from previous meeting.

**Clerks Business:** 6 emails have been received regarding the condition of Lake Rd. Several complaints are not from residence of the town. These are vacation homes. Selectmen agree that complaints should be brought directly to the selectmen at one of the meetings held on 2<sup>nd</sup> and 4<sup>th</sup> Tuesdays of the month at 6:00pm. Suggestions and ideas are welcome.

Chris Carone spoke with Billy Briggs and was advised not to pay the bill received regarding fire extinguishers. The bill is wrong, Billy Briggs he will look into it. Taking the fire extinguishers to Redstone may be cheaper.

**Treasures Report:** Warrant from last meeting needs to be amended. Warrant #9 new balance \$10308.09.

Reimbursement for MMA 2018 workman's comp in the amount of \$753.00 was received.

Reimbursement from state in regards to culvert on Lake Rd. has been received.

The electric bill for the sand and salt shed is high because the loader is plugged in through out the winter.

TAN note offer is \$250,000 @ 3.41%. Selectmen approve the offer and will use it on an "as needed" basis.

A separate warrant will be issued for the sale of the excavator to the Town of Lovell. Current payoff is \$42878.50.

**Old Business:** Roads are the biggest problem the town is facing. Jim Wilfong inquired on amounts of sand used, hauled and cost. Jim Wilfong has spoken with Freddie Wilson about screening sand for winter and rock crushing. He is waiting on quotes.

Selectmen agree to have Howard Allen continue to mow cemeteries.

**New Business:** Harold and Melanie having been cleaning culverts. The culvert on Wiley Rd. is gone and needs to be replaced. Union Hill and Lake Rd. have been York raked.

The state inspector was at the Ezra Heald Bridge.

Selectmen will be working on a plan regarding the Ezra Heald Bridge, town roads, culverts replacement. Looking for estimates on repairing the shed roof at the sand and salt shed.
